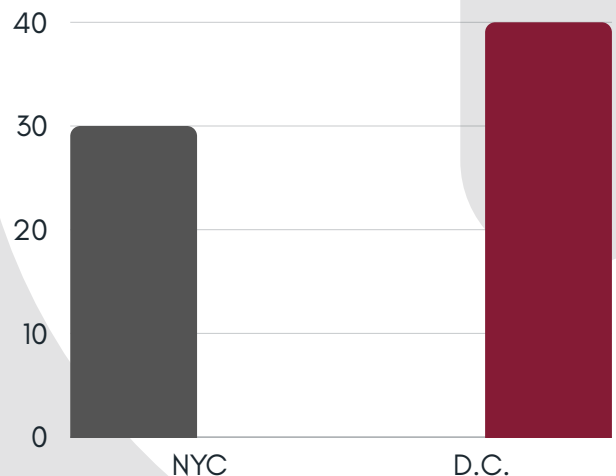
A Special Note
